Hence, we do not sell any alcoholic beverages, and the consumption of alcohol and drug is forbidden. The organising team may decide to exclude a participant who chooses to ignore this rule.

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NO ANIMALS

Animals aren't allowed on all Lou Tuquet camping premises, even on a leash, to respect the collective need for serenity and cleanliness.

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PARENTS' RESPONSIBILITY

Festi'Thai offers a space dedicated to kids: Festi'kids. Children, as well as all minors attending the festival, remain under the full responsibility of their legal guardians, especially out of Festi'kids' opening hours. Parents are responsible for the respect of Festi'thai and Festi'kids' values.

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RESPECT OF OTHERS AND THE ENVIRONMENT

The camping zone is solely dedicated to rest. Please remain silent from 10PM to 7AM the next day.

The festival grounds are a non-smoking area, with dedicated smoking spots. For the collective well-being, please use these spots to smoke if needed.
